NEW NO SMOKING LAWS

From 7th January 2013, new smoke free outdoor area laws have been introduced throughout NSW.

Recent amendments to the Smoke-free Environment Act mean that smoking is now banned:

- Within 10 metres of children's play equipment
- In spectator areas of sports grounds or other recreational areas

Although the LANSW Smoke Free Policy already prohibits smoking in spectator areas, it should be notied that this is now a legislation banned in spectator areas at public sports grounds and other recreational areas in NSW.
